Fees can be paid by cash, check or credit card and will be returned if you are not selected to participate in the competition.

Entry forms and fees must be received by The Green Project by November 15, 2009, if you would like to receive your Project Packet on time. Late entries are accepted, but there are only 50 available spots, and acceptance into the competition is not guaranteed. The Green Project will notify you of acceptance into the competition within one week of receiving your packet.

If you are accepted into the competition, you will receive your Project Packet within one week. The Project Packet will have detailed information about the competition requirements, rules and expectations – ***please do not assume they are the same as last year.***
