Accepted donations:

Lumber, Trim, Plywood Ect.

Minimum length of 4 ft. and in reusable condition.
Plywood or sheetrock must be a full or half sheet.
Lumber with nails- accepted at staff discretion.
Lumber with excessive pest infestations, or rot is not accepted.

Doors

All solid doors are accepted at staff discretion.
Wood and aluminum screen doors. (Aluminum doors must have complete frame.)
*Cannot accept doors with: bowing, drastic alterations or need for major repair.

Windows

Windows should be free of damage beyond simple repair.
Window casings without matching sash are accepted at staff discretion.

Kitchen & Bathroom Cabinets

Cabinets should be free of damage beyond simple repair.
Cabinets with water damage or missing doors or drawers are accepted at staff discretion.

Tubs & Sinks

Sinks must be free of the following: chips, cracks, and deep scratches.
Wall mount sinks should include wall bracket, if possible.

Toilets

Toilets must be complete with tank and lid.
Toilets must be free of chips or cracks.

Recycle for the Arts

Antiques, art books, art & drafting supplies, buttons, canvas, costume elements, decorations, fabric, art glass, gift wrap, glue, glitter, hats, matte board, ribbons ect..

Recycling

Aluminum and Steel Cans
Newspaper & magazines
Cardboard
Electronic Recycling , such as computers, radios & cellphones (NO microwaves or televisions!)
NO PLASTIC OR GLASS

We do not accept the following:

- Hollow core doors
- Garage doors
- Furniture
- Carpet
- Batteries
- Appliances
- Clothes
- Non-building materials such as toys, dishes, silverware, etc.
